Literacy


We completed our baseline assessments this week and will be setting goals for our learning this fall. A copy of your child's learning goals will be coming home next week. The children will be ready to show you how much they have learned at our learner led conference on November 9th.

Math

During this week, our math class learned to classify, count, and sort objects. Learners matched pairs of objects according to attributes such as color, size, purpose, pattern, and position. They discovered that some pairs of items are identical ("exactly the same"), while others are similar but have differences, too. For example, "Both of these balloons are red, but one balloon is big and one is small."


Ask your child.....

- ★ to identify and color objects that are identical. Can your child match objects that are similar, but have minor differences? See if he or she can draw objects that are used together.
- ★ to write their name using a capital letter to begin their name and lowercase letters for the rest of the letters in their name. Can they tell you which letter is size 1, 2, or 3?

Dear Families,

We learned about **Size Matters Handwriting** expectations when practicing our names this week. There are three sizes of letters: size 1 letters touch the top and bottom lines, size 2 letters touch the dotted line and rest on the base line, and size 3 letters touch the dotted lines and go below the base line because they have a tail. The learners practiced identifying and making straight, slanted, "super C", clock lines, and smiley and frowning lines. This will help us with correct letter formation as we begin our work with letters next week.
